Special Need for New Generator

A few years ago, our electricity went out for four days in the middle of the Summer following a bad storm. We thought we could barely survive. No refrigerator; no air conditioning; no lights; no fans; NO FUN! Well, that happens on a regular basis in Haiti at the mission. Following the 2010 earthquake, electricity finally became available to the mission. However, eight years later -- the electricity is sporadic and unreliable. Which is why the mission relies so heavily on our industrial generator which is over 15 years old and needs repairs nearly every week. It is on its last leg and needs to be replaced.

The price is astronomical for a small mission like ours – \$21,500, and we are not sure if that price will stick following the recent riots. LHM is embarking on a drive to raise the funds for a new industrial generator. Several churches have already responded and have donated (or will donate) over half of the purchase price. We need to raise \$10,000 more, and we are asking supporters to help us raise the remaining funds. If not raised by the October 13, 2018 Benefit (at Der Dutchman in Plain City), we will try to use some/most of the funds from the Benefit for the generator.

Please consider a special gift to LHM for the generator. Any amount would be greatly appreciated! If sending a check, please designate the check as “For Generator” in the memo line. Thank you for your generous support and prayers. – Stacy Lane, Vice President.

Reflections on Haiti

from some team members sent by Zion Church in Michigan

HAITI OVERWHELMS ME! The time always goes by so quickly; I become sad when I realize all the things I wanted to do but didn't have the chance to. How much I will miss all those who tugged so hard at my heart-strings. Then, the wind blows and I feel the Holy Spirit and I rejoice with a gladful heart for the opportunity to have been there and over all of the things I did with my team mates, the countless children, the many teachers, and especially with our host family.

It's what they *don't* have (running water, electricity, sanitation controls...) that we first see.

It's the joy, happiness, sweltering heat, fun, loving & caring spirits of the people (young, old & in between) there that we **feel** – intensely.

It's the roosters crowing, dogs barking, turkeys gobbling, kids laughing, music being played and sung, that we **hear** – and it resonates to our soul.

It's the mouth-watering aroma from the grill, the garbage being burned, strolling by the fowl-coop, the sweat and perspiration of the young men working, a walk by the dog kennel, an exceptionally pleasant waft from the cooking school that tickles our sense of **smell**.

When the time comes to leave, in our own ways, we each do an assessment, where we each come to the conclusion, the Haitian people *have* so much **more** in so many ways than we *ever* will. Is it any wonder I can't wait to go back again? I think NOT! – Terri

Living Hope Ministries is a 3-acre campus, including a church, a school for pre-K through 6th graders to learn English, math, and science, and a trade school for grades 6th–adult, that teaches cooking, sewing, and welding. After learning their skills, the students may often go on to start a small business or come back to teach at Living Hope trade school. This is truly God at work.

I witnessed firsthand the joy of children receiving gifts from their Michigan sponsors; each gift was opened slowly and with great care, and then each child wrote a thank you note to their sponsors. I am now sponsoring the cutest little boy who is going to be three years old in December. I look forward to our friendship and the opportunity to visit him on my next trip.

Mary Jane and Andris and their wonderful family made us feel right at home from the time we arrived. Living Hope is definitely doing God's work. You could see that the children loved the school. The teachers were great to work with. I taught crafts to over 250 kids, making Christmas ornaments as the teachers read about the birth of Jesus. One of the biggest moments for me was the opportunity to share with the 3rd – 6th grade boys some gently used soccer uniforms and balls collected by the Donaldson family. The joy in their faces as they received their soccer jerseys was a ministry in itself. TLC Mission team donated 12 Singer treadle sewing machines. We also brought 6 world globes, giving the children the perspective to see that we are all on the earth together and to show them where we all call home: Michigan, Ohio, and Haiti. It was exciting for all of us. This trip to serve in Haiti was my first time at Living Hope. I fell in love right away; I could clearly see the work of God everywhere I looked. Ways You Can Become Involved With the Ministry Here at Home: Each summer, everyone at the Mission gets really busy preparing for the next school year. Did you know that it costs about \$8,000 – \$12,000 to purchase textbooks and school supplies to have the school ready to operate in the fall? That comes out to approximately \$20 to \$35 per student for each of the 350 students enrolled in just the elementary school. It doesn't seem like much compared to what it costs in the schools in our country. But in Haiti, that can be a fortune to a needy family! And, unfortunately, it's a reality that summer is our lowest giving time. If your church puts on a Vacation Bible School, do you collect offerings from the kids who attend for a special use or project? Would it be possible to allocate some or all of the offerings to Living Hope Ministries in Haiti to supply the students with school books and other school materials? If that might be possible, I would be happy to visit your VBS coordinator to tell them all about Living Hope!
