What's happening at LHM? We see God's goodness to us! We are grateful!

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. *1 Thessalonians 5:16-18*

Over the last few years, the circumstances in Haiti have made life difficult. There have been "ups and downs," but many times we seem to notice only the "downs." We want to share some of the "ups" with you this time. Here are some excerpts from Mary Jane's and Andris' emails:

"Here is a Praise report for the newsletter about how God is providing for us here – Back on Sept 18th we finally found and purchased diesel fuel for the generator. It then became very difficult (again) to find diesel fuel until lately in our area. Our area was very dangerous and impassable in Oct, Nov, and Dec, even early January. Normally, we purchase diesel fuel at least once every 1-2 months (especially since we really have not had government electricity for over a year – except for five days or so). Since January, we have been limiting generator time to only the essentials: pumping water for the school, the kitchen, the orphanage, us, etc. We fill tanks and containers with water to last for several days. During this time, I know I was praying for God to keep us going with the little bit of diesel in the generator, just like He did for the widow with the dwindling meal and oil (1Kings 17:8-16). We just got some diesel fuel last week!!! <u>God is so good to us</u>! Now they are hording the fuel again."

"Another really important thing happened. In 2022, we set up a large inverter and solar panels for the church building and one for our apartment and the guesthouse. Then we set up smaller inverters with their own solar panels and placed one in the primary school, one in the cooking school, and one in the U-building (Sewing and Computer classes). This was an important upgrade for the mission and has allowed us to keep church services and classes functioning without the generator. <u>God is awesome</u>!"

"In March and April: <u>It was quieter overall in our area</u>. We have been able to run the schools and even return to more normal school hours. The orphanage staff and children remain here. Currently, we have no other staff or families staying on campus. We know God has us here for a reason. We continue to pray and believe God for the safety of our staff, students, and community."

"Andris continues with overall supervision of the mission, maintenance, church services, Bible Studies, and whatever else needs to be done. Mary Jane fills in, teaching the cooking and embroidery classes as needed and continues to work on paperwork, curriculums, and fixing computer and printer problems as possible. <u>Our primary school administrators are becoming more efficient in making good decisions during these difficult times.</u> We lost our Primary School website, which has all the class curriculums for the parents, so we are working with the person who originally helped us set it all up. They have had to start over with a new program <u>(actually, this one appears to be free and even better in many ways!)</u>."
