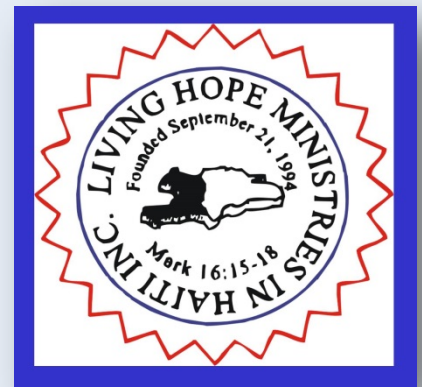

God is Always Faithful!

- With some special donations we have been able to finally purchase some cabinets for the guest house, church office and the church storage room. This is the first time we have had storage in most of these locations. What a blessing to finally be able to put things away and not have boxes setting everywhere.
- The church sound system went down several weeks ago. Thirteen receptors/transistors, etc. were blown in the power box. So we had a sound tech and sound engineer working close to three weeks to get us up and running. We plan to add an equalizer and backup power to the system with a cross-over. The sound was beautiful and full Sunday morning after several weeks of no sound system.
- A new air conditioner has been purchased to replace the one that caught on fire after it was installed a year ago and was struggling to keep up with the heat of Haiti.
- Construction is planned to begin on Phase I of the Professional School building (U-building) restoration over the Primary School summer break.
- We have helped two women in the Women's group with the entrepreneurship funds. Josephine has four children, her husband left her for another woman some time back and she is really struggling to keep food and clothes on the children. She was thrilled. Then Mikael, who has two children and no husband, had been very ill and spent most of her money on meds, tests and doctors. She has now recovered but her small food business has been severely hurt. Therefore, we were able to help her get back up on her feet.
- The donation funds received go many places, helping many constantly. Paulene, our primary school directrice's mother, has been critically ill; Lysberly has been battling Typhoid again, as has Joe. Lourdy, has been fighting high blood pressure and losing consciousness, so she hasn't been to work for three weeks either.

Living Hope Update

God is so great and so timely. Last summer and fall, we felt a great urgency to repair, reinforce and raise parts of the back wall on the mission complex. We became very aware of the weakness of the wall after we started the project. We ran into many obstacles such as a neighbor closing off part of the access to our wall, leaving only 20+ cm between their wall and ours, blocking the water/rain drainage so it builds up and runs into the mission in the holes they put in our blocks. Neighbors and others were not happy that we were doing all the upgrades to the wall. Only in February did they begin to understand why. We had torrential rains, the water was 4-6 feet up the wall and the wall held tight. We had some water come in under the back door, but that was manageable. Both of our roads were impassable. One washed away leaving a 2-foot trench so no vehicle could cross; the other road had 4-6 feet of rock and mud from the mountainsides.

The preschool registrations went great the end of May—we registered close to 90 three-year olds for the upcoming year. Kindergarten graduation was the 26th of June. The national exams for the trade school are taking place in July and August.

We have been working at finishing painting the bathrooms at the guesthouse. We have also been working on yard upkeep and improvements with the rains and all. Come and see.

The Negley's (Pastor Rick, Karen, Hope and Mary) came in the 25th to do a 4-day family seminar. We were very excited about their arrival.

We purchased a pull plugger/ switch disconnect for the transformer with a special donation, because we felt it is essential to have this tool present in case of an emergency.
